## Scripture reading:

- John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that every one who believes into Him would not perish, but would have eternal life.
- Luke 15:11 And He said, A certain man had two sons.
  - And the younger of them said to the father, Father, give me the share of the estate that falls to me. And he distributed to them his living.
  - And not many days after, the younger son, having gathered everything together, went abroad to a distant country and there squandered his estate by living dissolutely.
  - And when he had spent all, a severe famine occurred throughout that country, and he began to be in want.
  - 15 And he went and joined himself to one of the citizens of that country; and he sent him into his fields to feed hogs.
  - And he longed to be satisfied with the carob pods which the hogs were eating, and no one gave him anything.
  - 17 But when he came to himself, he said, How many of my father's hired servants abound in bread, but I am perishing here in famine!

- I will rise up and go to my father, and I will say to him, Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you.
- 19 I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants.
- And he rose up and came to his own father. But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was moved with compassion, and he ran and fell on his neck and kissed him affectionately.
- And the son said to him, Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son.
- But the father said to his slaves, Bring out quickly the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet.
- And bring the fattened calf; slaughter it, and let us eat and be merry,
- Because this son of mine was dead and lives again; he was lost and has been found. And they began to be merry.
