Announcement of

2011 Chinese-Speaking Students Perfecting Training

Dear Brothers,

Over the past three decades, more than a million students from Mainland China have enrolled in colleges and universities in North America. Although their primary purpose is to receive higher education, many of them sense the vanity of human life; hence, they are thirsty for the gospel. Because we did not preach the high gospel to them in the past, tens of thousands were gained by the denominations. By the year 2000, 150 Chinese-speaking students gained by the denominations had given up their master's degrees or Ph.D.s and their high paying jobs to enroll in various seminaries, and about 50 of these had already graduated and become full time pastors and preachers. A number of these became opposers to the Lord's recovery because of the influence of Christianity. Due to this situation, many saints in the Lord's recovery have become burdened by the Lord to preach the gospel of the kingdom to these Chinese-speaking students.

By the year 2003, about 300 Chinese-speaking students had been saved in the local churches. Because of this we felt the need to coordinate with the local churches to shepherd and perfect these newly saved students. Based on brother Witness Lee's fellowship and leading in the books *Rising Up to Preach The Gospel* (chapter 1) and *Elder's Training—Book 4* (chapter 10) to carry out a one week perfecting training for these newly saved ones, we started the perfecting training in the summer of that year. Our burden in perfecting these students is to help them to see the vision of the Lord's recovery, to know the Body of Christ, to be equipped with the divine truth, to have the proper spiritual growth, to live a God-man living, and to serve as living and functioning members of the Body so that they may be enabled to stand for the Lord's testimony and spread the gospel of the kingdom wherever they may go. We can testify concerning the work of the Holy Spirit and the Lord's abundant blessing in these trainings. We also can testify that many of those who have returned to China after being perfected in America have had a positive impact on the local churches there.

In order to continue the perfecting work of these Chinese-speaking students, we will hold the ninth one week perfecting training in Franklin Park, New Jersey from July 29th to August 5th. Also, a three day training will be held in Plano, Texas; Santa Clara and Diamond Bar, California from August 4th to August 7th, 2011 (these trainings should not be taken as a replacement of either the Summer Training in Anaheim or any regular regional Chinese-speaking conference). A number of co-workers from North America, Taiwan, and Hong Kong will coordinate to release messages on truth, life, vision, and service. We look to the Lord for His blessing upon this training and for many more students to be captured to meet His need.

We ask you to pray for this burden and encourage those Chinese-speaking students and their serving ones in your locality to register and participate in this training. If the elders feel that anyone

in their locality is not suitable for participation in this training due to either their spiritual or physical condition, please let us know, as this would help us in our review of the application.
